

AB 2843 Health care coverage: Rape and Sexual Assault

All services related to the listed diagnosis below do not require prior authorization. This is to comply with AB2843. This includes, but is not limited to, nine-month coverage period and the prohibition of any conditions on coverage related to the filing of a police report, criminal charges against an assailant, or the conviction of an offense.
